Accessibility Statement - elot.gr

The Hellenic Organization for Standardization, an independent operational unit of the National Quality Infrastructure System, is committed to making accessible the content published on the website www.elot.gr, in accordance with the provisions of Law 4727/2020 (Government Gazette 184 A' 23-09-2020), as applicable, excluding the content of websites of third parties other than elot.gr, which are accessible through links (case (e) of par. 3 of art. 37 of Law 4727/2020).

Compliance status

This website fully complies with the accessibility requirements of Article 39 of Law 4727/2020 and is in partial compliance with the WCAG 2.1 (Level AA) standard.

Specifically, the website has incorporated the <u>UserWay</u> Website Accessibility Widget, which is powered by a special accessibility server (offering a range of features for use by persons with disabilities - including those with visual, hearing, cognitive and mobility impairment). This widget resolves most accessibility issues at WCAG 2.1 Level AA.

Preparation of this accessibility statement
